SUMMARY The Maintenance Mechanic I position is responsible for supporting manufacturing and processing operations. The Maintenance Mechanic I will help support the Maintenance Mechanic II in all preventative and routine maintenance and repair of all equipment associated with the breaking, pasteurizing, and packaging process.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include learning the following:

 - Changing oils as needed on various machinery
 - Upkeep grease intervals and record for reference
- Continuously demonstrate safe work habits.

- Support activities and programs to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Keep machine and equipment downtime minimal in order to maintain plant efficiencies optimal.
- Will report any food safety and quality issues/concerns to their manager and/or quality team.
- Assist with production needs from a maintenance standpoint as well as general support when needed.
- Must learn and follow Plant GMPs.
- Must learn and follow company safety and OSHA guidelines.
- Pursue opportunities to improve self.
- Support the Breaking Manager in achieving goals and metrics established for the Breaking Department.
- Perform other duties as assigned or appropriate.
